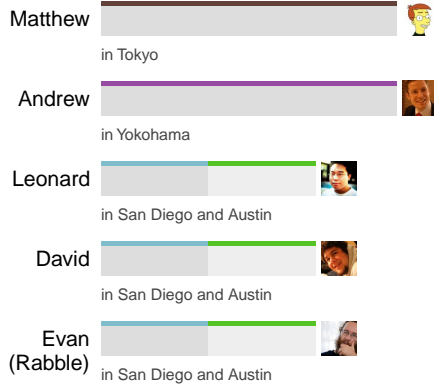


2008 Personal annual report for Ian Kennedy

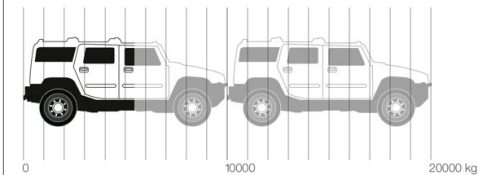


You spent the longest in Tokyo, Andrew Shuttleworth has a tip:
